(Note: The "Show Reader" (AA) View Option isn't available on All Websites and Articles. When you Tap on (AA) and the list has "Show Reader" in Gray, then "Show Reader" View isn't available on this website or article. [See I, II, & III below])

I. How To Print Safari Web Pages Without Ads ...

1. Start on the Article or Webpage That You Want to Print ...

- <u>Tap</u> on the (AA) I<u>con</u> to the <u>Left</u> of Your <u>Browser Address Bar ...</u>
- **Tap** on the **Show Reader** View ...
- The (AA) Icon Should Now be Black, and the <u>Article/Webpage</u> should be Cleaner ...
- Then, <u>Tap</u> the **Share Icon** at the **Bottom** of the <u>Screen</u> ...
- Scroll Down and Tap Print, Select Your (Air) Printer and Tap Print again.

II. How To Save A Web Page As A PDF On An iPhone ...

1. Open Safari And Go To The Web Page You Want To Save ...

- <u>**Tap**</u> on the **(AA)** <u>**Icon**</u> to the **Left** of Your <u>Browser Address</u> <u>Bar</u> ...
- Select Show Reader View, Tap the Share Icon at the Bottom of the Screen ...
- Scroll through the Share Options and Select the Books Icon
- Once you <u>Select</u> the <u>Books App</u>, the file will be prepared, and the <u>Books App</u> will <u>Open</u> and <u>Save</u> your new <u>PDF</u>.

III. How to Take an iPhone Scrolling Screenshot ...

- Open the Web Page in Safari that you'd like to <u>Capture</u> and <u>Take A</u> <u>Screenshot</u> as you normally would.
 - <u>Tap</u> the <u>Screenshot Preview</u>, that <u>Pops Up</u> in the <u>Lower-left Corner</u> of your screen ...
 - Tap "Full Page" Tab at the Top of your Screen ...
 - Tap Done ...
 - You'll be **Given** the **Options** to **Save PDF to Files**, **Delete Screenshot**, or **Cancel** ...
 - <u>Tap Save PDF to Files</u> to <u>Save</u> your PDF Scrolling Screenshot ...
 - <u>Choose</u> Where to <u>Save</u> your <u>PDF Scrolling Screenshot</u> And <u>Tap</u> Save.

IV. How To Scan A QR Code With The Camera ...

- 1. Open the Settings App ...
 - Tap the Camera Icon ...
 - Scroll to the Scan QR Codes Option and Tap It On (Highlight Button).
 - Open the Camera App ...
 - Hold the Camera Over the QR Code and Center It in the Frame ...
 - A Notification will <u>Appear</u> and <u>Display</u> What the AR Code <u>Opens</u> ...
 - Tap On the Notification to Open the QR Destination Link or ...
 - Tap On the Notification to Open the Phone Number.

V. How to Write Notes from Your iPhone Lock Screen ...

- 1. Open the Settings App ...
 - Tap on Control Center Icon ...
 - Scroll Down and Tap on Notes, a Green (+) Button.
- 2. Open the Settings App ...
 - <u>Tap On</u> the Face ID & Passcode or Touch ID & Passcode (Based on iPhone Model) then Enter Your iPhone's Passcode ...
 - Scroll Down will Turn On the Control Center Button ...
 - Test It ... Put Your iPhone To Sleep, Press the Side Button to Wake It Up, Swipe Down From the Upper Right Corner (or Bottom Up Half-Way) to Get the Control Panel ... <u>Tap On Notes Icon</u> and <u>Write</u> a Note!

VI. How to Decline Call on iPhone in 3 Ways ...

- 1. If the Call Comes in While you are Using the iPhone, then <u>Tap</u> Decline/ Hang Up Button.
- 2. If the Call Comes when the iPhone is Locked or Asleep, <u>Press</u> the Side Button <u>Twice</u> (Since the Decline Option <u>Won't Be On</u> the Screen).
- 3. If You're <u>Using AirPods Pro</u>, <u>Double Press</u> the Force Sensor on the Stem of your AirPod Pro to <u>Decline</u> the Call, and <u>Send It</u> to Voicemail. If you're <u>Using First-generation AirPods</u>, you can <u>Tap</u> the <u>Side of Either AirPod Twice</u>, which will <u>Answer the Call</u>. <u>Tapping It Twice Again</u> will End It.

VII. How to Delete Digits in iPhone Calculator ...

- 1. On Home Screen, <u>Swipe</u> (Right Top Down or Bottom Up Half-Way) For Control Center ...
 - <u>Tap</u> on Calculator Icon ...
 - <u>Tap Numbers</u> 123446, Then <u>Swipe</u> Over the Numbers (From Right to Left Or Left to Right) Two Times, And then <u>Tap</u> the 5 and 6 ...
 - Now you have the Correct Number ... 123456.

VIII. How Forward a Text Message on an iPhone ...

- 1. Open Messages, Open a Conversation with the Text to Forward ...
 - Long Press on the Body of the Message and Tap "More"...
 - All the Messages will have small circles to the Left of each Text. <u>Tap</u> the Circle Next to any other Messages you also want to <u>Forward</u> ...
 - <u>Tap On</u> the Forward Icon and a New Message will <u>Open</u> ...
 - Enter your Recipient's Contact Information ...
 - <u>Tap On</u> Send. (Much better than Retyping the Message.)

IX. How to Take a Still Photo While Shooting Video ...

- 1. Open the Camera App ...
 - Swipe Over to Video (or Tap Video in the Mode Menu) ...
 - Tap the Red Shutter Button in the Bottom Center to Start Recording Video ...
 - To Take a Still Photo while you're Recording, <u>Tap</u> the White Shutter Button Located in the Bottom Right Corner of the Screen. The photo will Automatically Save to your Photos App.

X. How to Take a Selfie with Siri ...

- 1. Say, "Hey Siri" to activate Siri. (Or hold the Home button or Side button) ...
 - <u>Say</u>, "Hey Siri, Take a Selfie <u>Photo</u>." (If you only say, "Hey Siri, take a Selfie", Siri will start reading you the definition of a selfie from the web)...
 - Siri will <u>Open</u> the Camera App on your iPhone in Photo Mode on your Front-Facing camera.
 - Now <u>Tap</u> the <u>Shutter Button</u> to <u>Take</u> your <u>Selfie</u>. (You can also use the Volume up or down buttons on the side of your iPhone.)
